Consent to participate in the Event

hereby give consent for the Student to participate in the Event, unless I shall instruct MAD Summit organisers (MAD) otherwise in writing.

- I have read, understood and agreed to the following terms and conditions before signing this Consent & Release Form. I have explained these terms and conditions to my child/ward. I have also ensured that my child/ward who will be participating in the MAD Youth Summit 2020 understand the terms and conditions set forth below.

Release and Indemnity

I, with this, acknowledge and agree that in consideration of the Student to participate in the Event, agree to the following:

- 1) I fully understand and accept that while Leaderonomics Community will take every precaution and care, they cannot eliminate certain risks that come with participation in the Event. I acknowledge and accept all of the inherent risks associated with the Student's participation in the Event and the possibility of personal injury, property damage or loss resulting from them and agree to assume all the risks and waive notice of all conditions, danger or otherwise, in or about the Event;
- 2) I now expressly and irrevocably confirm that, to the best of my knowledge, my child's/ward's general state of health is good. He/she has no medical condition that could be adversely affected by any of the activities planned or reasonably expected to be involved in the Event. I also understand that it is the responsibility of the Parent or Legal Guardian to inform MAD Youth Summit organisers of any changes to the Student's medical condition.
- 3) Leaderonomics Community reserves the right to discontinue my child/ward from participating in the Event if my child/ward may expose himself/herself to the risk of illness, injury or death. I shall take all reasonable steps to ensure and to cause my child/ward to take reasonable steps to ensure his/her health and safety condition.
- 4) I agree to release, save harmless and indemnify MAD Youth Summit, Leaderonomics Community & partners, its employees, invitees, volunteers and agents (herein collectively called "the Personnel") from and against all claims, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses whatsoever in respect to injury, loss or damage to my person or property, in connection with the Students taking part in the Event or while travelling to and from the Event unless caused by act or negligence of the School or the Personnel;
- 5) I further understand, acknowledge and agree that at any time MAD Youth Summit organisers reserve the right to decline continued participation to any persons if their behaviour is causing unreasonable disturbances.
- 6) I now expressly and irrevocably grant Leaderonomics Community permission to utilise my child's/ward's appearance in connection with the Event in any manner and media and all rights of every kind and character whatsoever in perpetuity and to my performance, appearance, name, and/or voice and the results and proceeds thereof ("Performance") in connection with the Event.

- 7) I now authorise Leaderonomics Community to photograph and record (on film, digital, video, tape or otherwise) the Performance of my child/ward concerning the Event. To edit the same at its sole discretion and to include it with the performance of others and with sound effects, special effects and music; to incorporate the same into any other program; to use and to license others to use such recordings and photographs in any media or whatsoever, including unrestricted use for publicity, advertising and sales promotion; and to use my child's/ward's name, likeness, voice, biographic or other information concerning my child/ward in connection with the Event, commercial tie-ups, merchandising, and for any other purpose as Leaderonomics Community deems fit and appropriate.

I agree that the recorded Performance of my child/ward in connection with the Event may be edited in Leaderonomics Community's sole discretion. I consent to the use of my child's/ward's name, likeness, voice and/or biographic material by Leaderonomics Community in connection with the Event's publicity and related institutional promotional purposes. I expressly release Leaderonomics Community, its agents, employees, licensees and assignees from and against all claims which I and/or my child/ward have or may have for invasion of privacy, defamation or any other cause of action arising out of the production, distribution, broadcast or exhibition of the Performance concerning the Event.

Authorisation to attend to accident or emergency

In the event of an accident or emergency, while every attempt will be made to contact me, I at this moment authorise MAD Youth Summit organisers or any of the Personnel to make such arrangements as he/she deems necessary for the Student to receive medical/hospital care. Which includes getting the necessary transportation. Under such circumstances, I further authorise any designated medical practitioner to undertake such care and treatment to the Student as he/she considers necessary, including x-ray examination, anaesthetic, medical, dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment.

Transport conditions for Activities outside of HIS

The safety and security of the students is always our main priority. As such, the following conditions have been put in place to ensure that every student remains safe under the care and supervision of the MAD Youth Summit and the Personnel running it:

- Students are encouraged to take the school transport to and from the Event.
- If Parents/Guardians would like to take the Student directly to the Event venue, we require that they notify MAD Youth Summit and/or the Personnel in charge via email before the Event date.
- If Parents/Guardians are late in picking up the Student from the Event venue, for safety and security reasons, the Student will take the school transport. **NOTE THAT WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WAIT FOR PARENTS WHO ARE LATE.**
- If the Event concludes before the scheduled completion time and Parents/Guardians are not yet present, the student will be required to wait at the premise of the MAD Youth Summit. They will not be allowed to leave the premises.
- Should the Parents/Guardians wish to organise a carpool for the Students from the Event venue, the Parents/Guardian need to notify (by email) the organisers or the Personnel in charge at least 72 hours before. The email should clearly state the Parents/Guardians who are picking up the Students and list the names of the students. Additionally, they must provide the approval of the Parents/Guardian of the other MAD Youth Summit students in the carpool.
- Please note that neither the MAD Youth Summit nor the Personnel shall be responsible for the Student once the Student is picked up or collected by the Parents/Guardians/Drivers as above.
- Please note that the Event may end earlier than anticipated and as such the Student may return from MAD Youth Summit earlier than the stated time given to the Parents/Guardians. In such an event, the Personnel in charge will make every effort to inform the Parents/Guardian of any time changes for early pick-up.

Acknowledgment of Understanding

I understand that I am freely and voluntarily giving the consent, release, indemnity and authorisation. Furthermore, I understand that I may revoke them at any time before the commencement of the Event by submitting the said revocation in writing to HIS. By doing so, I understand that the Student will not be able to participate further in the Event. I also understand that I can refuse to sign the MAD Youth Summit Form. If so, the Student will not be permitted to participate in the Event.
